

PROCLAMATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY
AND
LOCAL EMERGENCY ORDER

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to New York Executive Law Article 2-B and Section 24 thereof, and by reason of a disaster, catastrophe or similar public emergency within the territorial limits of **TOWN OF NEWCOMB** which imperils public safety, namely the severe and heavy snowfall, ice and sleet causing unsafe road conditions and threatening persons and property, a **LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY** is hereby proclaimed and declared to exist in **TOWN OF NEWCOMB** as of 8 (a.m./p.m. on 2/13, 2017. This state of emergency shall continue for a period of five (5) days, unless it is either sooner terminated by a declaration that the state of emergency no longer exists or the state of emergency is extended.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that during the period of the state of emergency and in order to protect life and property and to bring the emergency situation under control:

1. All departments and agencies in the Town of Newcomb shall take whatever steps are or may be necessary to protect life, property and public infrastructure, or to provide emergency assistance.

2. The Town of Newcomb Supervisor, Superintendent of Public Works, and all Department Heads are authorized and directed to enter into emergency contracts for necessary services required to ameliorate and remedy the emergency conditions with the Town of Newcomb.

3. All pedestrian and vehicular traffic, should be undertaken with care on all effected public roadways within the Town of Newcomb and the public shall observe all road closings which may be in effect.

4. All Town of Newcomb employees and departments are requested to monitor the current conditions and be prepared to mitigate any effects from snow and ice and to offer and provide any affected residents or persons necessary assistance, including shelter, food and other necessities.
