New York State has recently acquired three properties within the Town of Newcomb;
Boreas Ponds Tract - Macintyre East Tract- Macintyre West Tract.

The Adirondack Park Agency will hold a Public Hearing regarding the classification of these tracts on Wednesday, November 16th at 7:00 P.M. at Newcomb Central School.

Before assigning a classification the APA is soliciting public input. These lands will have the greatest benefit to our town and businesses if classified **Wild Forest**. The Wild Forest classification will allow public use of the lands for recreational purposes. In making the classification decision the APA values individual comments-this is where we can have a say.

In regards to the Boreas Ponds Tract, the APA will be presenting four alternative plans. Alternative #1 would allow the best access to the ponds for hikers, bicyclists, horseback riders, snowmobilers, cross-country skiers, snowshoers and the general public. It is important you speak to the Wild Forest classification for Boreas Ponds as an individual comment separate from the Macintyre Tracts.

Regarding Macintyre East, it is important to speak to this tract comment in favor of the Wild Forest classification.

Also, it is important to speak to the Macintyre West tract as a separate comment in favor of the Wild Forest classification.
